

NOTICE TO COMPETITORS:

Competitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of CDSP rules and regulations (see www.companiondogssportsprogram.com), including but not limited to the following rules regarding entry: • This trial is open to a dog at least six months of age, including purebred and non-purebred, except bitches in season or dogs with disabilities, injuries, or illnesses which may cause the dog pain or great discomfort, or dogs exhibiting signs of aggression that threaten the safety of other dogs or humans. • Dogs must be shown by a member of the owner's immediate family: mother, father, spouse, life partner, sibling, child, grandparent, or grandchild. • All dogs shall be shown in a flat buckle or snap collar, or properly fitted Martingale (limited slip) collar. No choke collar, prong collars, shock collars, harnesses, Martingale leads, or head collars are allowed. (See full rules for health exceptions for harnesses. Veterinarian letter is required.) • All dogs must be registered with CDSP on the day of competition. See www.companiondogssportsprogram.com to complete the registration form and submit it to the CDSP office.

- Safety shall always be of foremost consideration in actions and conduct by handlers at all times. Handlers, through entry at this event, accept full responsibility for themselves and the actions of their dogs.
- Any dog removed from the premises for aggressive or threatening behavior is not eligible for a refund and not eligible for any placements and/or awards.
- The organizing committee may refuse any entry for any reason.
- Refunds for females in season will be given upon receipt of a statement by the exhibitor's veterinarian, less a \$5.00 processing fee.
- No refunds will be given after close of pre-entries on September 20, 2024. A \$5.00 handling fee will be deducted from the refund of entries that are withdrawn prior to the closing date (other than those for females in season).
- No entry fees will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strike, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizers.
- All competitors through entry at this event grant to Companion Dog Sports Program, their representatives, agents, and assigns, all rights and permissions to use or appropriate the exhibitor's and the dog's name, biography, likeness, photograph, voice, performing persona, or other indicia or identity for broadcast, telecast, cablecast, transmission, or distribution in any format or media now known or hereafter to become known and waive any and all rights relative thereto.

Facility, Crating and Food

Doors open at 8 AM. Judging will begin at 9 AM.

Please place a mat under wire crates.

Dogs must be on leash anywhere on the grounds during the trial, except when competing.

Exhibitor Conduct:

Exhibitors are expected to conduct themselves in a sportsmanlike manner. Any exhibitor exhibiting unsportsmanlike conduct will be declared ineligible and asked to leave the premises.

Food:

Coffee, water and breakfast items will be available. Lunch and beverages will be available free for volunteers. There are fast food restaurants located nearby.

Directions to the Show Site:

From the North: From SB I-43 exit onto 794 and go south to Howard Ave. Turn left (East) then turn left at the light onto S Pennsylvania Ave. The building is on the right at the next corner. Parking lot & entrance are in the rear.

Awards in each trial:

Placement ribbons will be awarded to the top four (4) high scoring teams in all classes. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded in all classes to each team that achieves a qualifying score. A rosette will be awarded to High in Trial and High Combined in Trial for each trial.

Level title (SN-C, CD-C, CDX-C, UD-C, UDX-C, VT-C), Individual Level Championship title (ASN-C, CD-CCH, CDX-CCH, UD-CCH, VT-CCH), and Obedience Championship title (OTCH-C) ribbons/rosettes will be awarded. Please indicate anticipated titles on the table at the bottom of the General Agreement.

Entries:

(Fees include \$1.50 Results Filing Fee)

Pre-Entries: Must be received by September 19, 2025, after which time entries will be charged the Day of Show entry fee. **Pre-entries without payment will not be processed.** We are not accepting emailed entries.

Pre-Entry: \$24 per class **Starter Novice & Juniors** (age 17 and under): \$12 per class
Day of Show Entry Fee: \$29 per class, Starter Novice & Junior: \$17 per class

Day of Show entries will be accepted if the trials do not fill. Day of Show Entries for both shows will be accepted from 8 – 8:30AM and up until ½ hr prior to trial 2. Exhibitors planning to enter Day of Show should check with the trial secretary prior to the trial weekend to confirm that the trials have not filled.

Entry forms that are not complete and fully legible will be returned.
If the entry limit of 60 runs per day is reached before pre-entries close, a wait list will be established based on postmark date.
Any changes to entries, including cancellations, will be accepted until the closing date, September 19, 2025. Changes must be sent to the Trial Secretary by email or in writing.

Returned Check Policy:

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. There will be a \$30.00 service charge for returned checks. Payment of entry fees and service charges shall be made in cash or money order within 10 days of notice to exhibitor of returned check. Any unpaid fees or shortfalls must be paid prior to the start of the event or entry is canceled without recourse by owner/handler.

Move ups

If known prior to the trials, level/class move ups must be submitted to the Trial Secretary. Level move ups will be allowed between trials. Move ups from the A or B class to the C class are mandatory. Move-ups at the trials must be submitted to the Trial Secretary using the Move Up Form provided at the trials.

Accessibility:

Owners with disabilities are encouraged to enter. Any necessary modifications to the exercises must be provided by the handler to the judge and approved by the judge.

Confirmations:

Entry confirmation, and final confirmation and running order per trial will be emailed. Include a self-addressed stamped envelope to receive a mailed confirmation.

Which Class Do I Enter? A, B, and C Classes Explained

Starter Novice A: Shall be for dogs who have not earned any other obedience title in any registry and does not have a qualifying score (Q) in Novice in any obedience registry.

Starter Novice B: Shall be for dogs who have earned a Beginner Novice (BN) obedience title or equivalent in any registry and does not have a qualifying score (Q) in Novice in any obedience registry.

Starter Novice C: Shall be for dogs who have earned a CDSP Starter Novice title (SN-C) in either the A or B class and does not have a qualifying score (Q) in Novice in any obedience registry.

Novice A: Shall be for dogs who have not earned any other obedience title in any registry.

Novice B: Shall be for dogs who have earned an obedience title in any registry, including Starter Novice (SN-C).

Novice C: Shall be for dogs who have earned a CDSP Novice title (CD-C) in either the A or B class.

Open A: Shall be for dogs who have earned the CDSP Novice obedience title (CD-C).

Open B: Shall be for dogs who have earned the CDSP Novice obedience title (CD-C) and/or any other Open obedience titles in any registry.

Open C: Shall be for dogs who have earned a CDSP Open title (CDX-C) in either the A or B class.

Utility A: Shall be for dogs who have earned the CDSP Open obedience title (CDX-C).

Utility B: Shall be for dogs who have earned the CDSP Utility obedience title (UD-C) and who wish to earn a CDSP Utility Dog Excellent title (UDX-C) and a CDSP Obedience Trial Championship title (OTCH-C).

Utility C: Shall be for dogs who have earned the CDSP Utility obedience title (UD-C) and who wish to earn the CDSP Utility Championship obedience title (UD-CCH).

Versatility A: Shall be for dogs who have earned the CDSP Novice title (CD-C).

Versatility B: Shall be for dogs who have earned the CDSP Novice title (CD-C) and any other Open or Utility qualifying leg or obedience title in any registry.

Versatility C: Shall be for dogs who have earned a CDSP Versatility title (VT-C) in either the A or B class.

Jump Heights

Dogs are not required to be measured the day of the trial or prior to judging. However, judges have the option to measure any dog prior to his/her performance if the dog appears to be entered in a group lower than might be indicated by his/her registered shoulder height. Jump heights may be modified based on physical challenges that a particular dog may face.

5.5" and under	4
8.0" and under	6
11.0" and under	8
13.5" and under	10
16.0" and under	12
19.0" and under	14
21.5" and under	16
24.0" and under	18
27.0" and under	20
Over 27"	22

Veteran dogs (seven years and older) may jump 2" lower than regular jump height indicated above. Note: If modifying your dog's jump height, select the modified height on your entry and check the box to indicate modified height. You must also submit an Exercise Modification Form to be signed by the trial judge and attached to your score sheet for each trial.
